Alliance Women Ministries Annual Report
July 1, 2009 to June 30, 2010

Our theme for this past year, “Pass the Salt” with an urgency of intentional evangelism was carried out by our women. We had fifty four women make a decision for Christ through our Alliance Women Ministries. Praise the Lord!!! Our fall and spring rallies of the thirteen areas have demonstrated how we can pass the salt to those around us. Each monthly meeting, the women of our churches meet for prayer, discipleship, fellowship, outreach and missions.



The national project was to assist national churches to become missionary sending agencies, English as a second language, unreached people groups, marriage encounters, holistic ministries, open-air campaigns and to initiate ministry activity in partner churches. The Western Pennsylvania Alliance Women raised \$40,097 for these projects. Thank the Lord for every dollar!

The color for the project was blue and yellow; the motifs were kitchen utensils [salt and pepper]. Our women were very creative in using these to present the theme in their various meetings.

Annual Meeting and Luncheon

The Annual Meeting was held at Four Points Sheridan, Cranberry, PA, on April 28, 2010, with 133 in attendance. Our speakers were Ruth Ann Sarver, Director of Johnstown Area, who told of her eye healing and subsequent trip to Peru and Debbi Clouser, International Worker from Burkina Faso.

Annual Retreat

The Annual Retreat was once again held at the University of Pittsburgh, Johnstown Campus, on June 18-19, 2010. The theme was, “Daughters of the King, Truly Loved.” The speaker, Jane Rubietta and all the International Workers, tied it in very well when they spoke. The offering, \$7,483.45, from the 442 women in attendance, was designated for the Cinderella House of Spain. For a contribution of \$1.00, many ladies tried on Cinderella’s glass slipper to find the perfect fit. We also had a Cinderella Café which featured different coffee and tea flavors from around the world.
