# Workshops 2010

1. Breaking Through Church Barriers (Pastors only): Discover how to break through those tough church attendance barriers - 1 - 35 - 100 - 200 - 400+.

2. Capturing and Casting the Vision: How do you discern God's Vision for your church? How do you get your leadership on board with your vision? How do you help the congregation understand and own the vision? These and other questions will be answered in this workshop.

3. Church Treasurers' Alerts: Keep legal and up-to-date with matters pertaining to treasurer's responsibilities.

4. Community Outreach: Reaching out to your community sometimes means leaving the friendly confines of your church and getting out into the community. Learn ways to use community parks and peoples backyards to do outreach in your community.

5. Developing Mission Vision in Your Youth (2 Sessions): Find out what "you" can do in your youth ministries to develop a passion for the lost and the poor around the world in the hearts of your youth. You will be

given specific ideas of implementation. Workshop presenter, Pete Brokopp, is a missionary with The Christian and Missionary Alliance in Burkina Faso. He has challenged thousands of youth to make an impact for Christ in the world.

6. Elder Training: If as a pastor, you are looking for material that will help you in training your elders to be more effective in their role as elder, this is the seminar for you.

7. Finding Fulfillment as a Pastor's Wife: Do you sometimes struggle in your role as a pastor's wife? This seminar will delve into the multifaceted role of the pastor's wife and how you can be yourself in the role of the pastor's wife.

8. How to Get Started in Nursing Home Ministry: Learn what to say when you don't know what to say. Ministering in difficult situations.

9. How to Give Your Pastor More Without It Costing You More: Learn very legitimate (and legal) ways to provide for your pastor simply by restructuring his compensation package.

10. How to Grow Your Church in WPA: Re-

#### 16. Missions Partnerships:

Have you ever wondered how you can be more involved in reaching our world for Jesus Christ? How can you be more informed in prayer, in giving strategically, in going and sending people to participate in the work? How can you be on the cutting edge of what is taking place in regions where there are great needs? One of the ways that can significantly impact a church's life is through partnerships with our international workers around the world. These partnerships can take place in many ways. If you're looking for some fresh input on connecting with our international work, this would be a good seminar to attend.

#### 17. Pastor's Housing Allowance:

Learn the correct way to structure your pastor's housing/parsonage allowance. In so doing the church will operate in a legal manner and the pastor will not have to pay so much to Uncle Sam.

#### 18. Pastor's Taxes:

For both treasurers and pastors, know and file the pastor's tax return ac-

ording to IRS code in order to both save tax \$\$s and to stay out of jail.

#### 19. Planning and Implementing an Evangelistic Focused VBS:

Use VBS as an outreach and a tool to teach your kids about evangelism. Learn ways to make VBS an exciting outreach on any budget and be effective reaching not just kids in your church but in your community as well.

#### 20. Raising Leaders From the Harvest for the Harvest:

How do you identify leaders within the congregation and how do you develop them into leaders? This workshop will answer these questions and more regarding leadership development.

#### 21. Small Group Leader Training:

This workshop will assist the small group leader in identifying various types of people within a small group and learning how to deal with each one for the common good of the group.

#### 22. Special Needs Ministry:

Come and learn how to start an effective special needs/disability ministry for children through adults in your church.

#### 23. Viva la Difference:

Our marvelous Heavenly Father has created each of us to be uniquely different. But what happens when our unique qualities begin to rub other people the wrong way? In this session, we will celebrate our differences and explore the Scriptures for help in dealing with personal conflicts.

#### 24. Who Ya Gonna Call?:

Someone in your church has gotten involved in something shady, if not downright sinful. Following Matthew 18:15-18, you lovingly approached the person but were rebuffed. Even taking another person with you was not successful. What should you do? The C&MA policy on "Discipline, Restoration, and Appeal" has been newly revised to help us with situations like this. Students in this session will explore the newly revised discipline policy as it applies to the local church. Changes in policy will be highlighted and helpful companion tools will be distributed.
